Summer School Application 2008
Transition Program
(FOR INCOMING 6TH GRADERS ONLY)

The Transition Program is a pilot program for selected students matriculating from elementary to middle school. The program is part of secondary summer school, July 7 – August 1, 2008. The transition academic program is study/literacy skills and mathematics. The purpose of Summer School Transition is to acclimate the students to the next level, improve their academic self-efficacy, and increase their abilities to adjust and be successful in school.

Class size: 25:1
Enrollment: 150

Eligibility: Student eligibility is based on a combination of factors including scoring below basic/far below basic on the CST and periodic assessments in mathematics and being at-risk in study/social skills and attributes necessary for school success.

Curriculum: The curriculum includes mathematics and study/literacy skills courses. The program is designed in 4-hour daily blocks: 2 hours of mathematics and 2 hours of study/literacy skills.

Parent Component: Parents are required to attend two parent meetings at John Muir.
